A simple and efficient solution for controlling the outbreak of fire in vehicles. MAUS Dekke AUTO PRO is a “large format” fire blanket designed to extinguish a car fire in the initial phase. The purpose of the blanket is to suppress the fire by depriving it of oxygen. It allows rapid intervention to prevent flashovers and spreading of the fire to other vehicles or buildings.

- Reinforced pull straps* with cabin hook for optimal durability.
- 3 x pull straps* (6 in total) to create extra stability when covering the vehicle.
- Prevents the spread of vehicle fire by suppression.
- Prevents the fire from spreading to other vehicles or nearby buildings.
- Efficiently stops the release of toxic fumes.
- Limits the damages caused by the vehicle fire.
- Facilitates the task for responders to extinguish the fire.
