## Top quality camera

The external video unit has a **high definition camera** that is equipped with **infrared technology**. Even in the pitch dark, you can clearly see your visitors in detail. Thanks to the **wide camera angle** (no less than 155°), it is easy to keep your visitors in view, even when they move.





### Fully secure

You and only you decide who can access your home. All internal video units are connected to the Niko access control module securely. The mobile app, in turn, can only be activated by a **unique login** and password known only to you. And once installed, the **QR code** used to connect your mobile device **becomes inactive**. Which means nobody can gain access to your system without your permission.



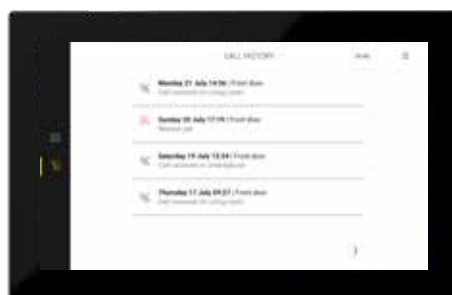
### Always stay connected

You can connect **up to 5 internal video units to the same module** and even use them as an **intercom** to connect different parts of your home. Or what about a **second external video unit** for your back door or home office? The **possibilities are endless**.
