Welcome to the 2024 Sport Fishing Show at Elmia in Jönköping!

The Sport Fishing Show is Sweden's biggest meeting-place for pleasure anglers, and also kicks off the new fishing season. The show is expanding, and interest in sport fishing goes on growing. The 2023 event was visited by 19,600 enthusiasts at Elmia in Jönköping.

More and more Swedes are getting into angling, and the sport is attracting enthusiasts of all ages – from beginners to pros, young and old alike. Around 2 million people go fishing at least once a year.

Of these, almost 600,000 are children and young people up to age 16. It's clear that these days it's quite trendy to be into fishing. It's also evident that more young people are starting to fish again. The industry is worth about SEK 6 billion a year – that's over EUR 600 million.

Sport fishing in Sweden – facts & figures


- Around 2.1 million Swedes fish every year, as well as around 800,000 tourists when they visit Sweden.
- The number of fishing days in 2021 amounted to around 12.4 million, of which 6.9 million from boat.
- Recreational fishing's total expenditure on consumables, fishing licences, travel, fishing guides, food and accommodation in 2021 amounted to approximately SEK 5.6 billion.
- Expenditures for larger purchases, for example boats or more expensive equipment, are estimated at SEK 9.7 billion.
- The total expenses in 2021 amounted to approximately SEK 15.3 billion.
- The total catch in pleasure angling is estimated at around 18,000 tonnes a year. About 10,600 tonnes are caught in lakes and watercourses, and about 7,700 tonnes along the coasts and in the sea.

So pleasure angling in Sweden is extensive and of great importance both to outdoor life and the social economy, especially in rural areas.


