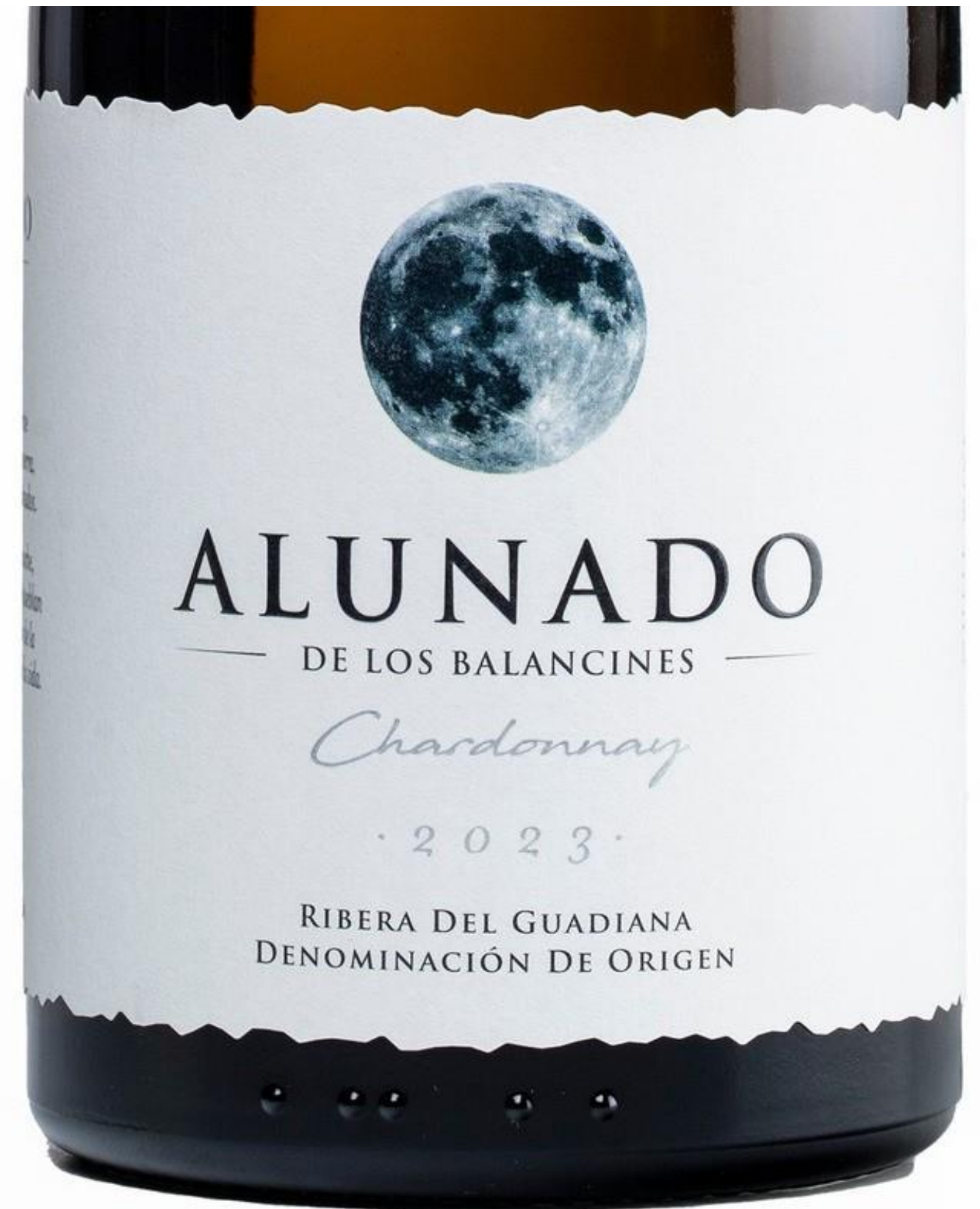

It is Pago los Balancines goal to dignify these vinescultivation, helping to avoid old vines to be pulled off, contributing to reward these men and women commitment to not replace their vines for more profitable cultivations. And, to maintain a wine profile that will disappear if we do not commit to maintain it.



PARCELAS HISTÓRICAS: BARBAS DE GATA 2020

Tasting notes

Ruby colour, pale intensity announcing a light body and agility. Fresh nose, wild fruit and resinous notes. Wet stone, and light smoked aromas. Good acidity and very tasty in the mouth, but agile and direct, Silky tannins and very nice aftertaste

100% Garnacha (Pre-phylloxera vines from Sierra de Gata (Cáceres))

Crianza - Ageing

Is produced in open old barrels, through completely handmade processes, with native yeasts, and very low intervention; It has 12 months ageing in very used French barrels.

PARCELAS HISTÓRICAS:VIÑA DE BUENAVISTA 2019

Tasting notes

Bright, deep garnet colour. Nose with ripe red and fresh black fruit, sweet peppers and clove, balsamic, rockrose and undergrowth, wet stone and mineral freshness. Full but agile on the palate, polished tannin, well- balanced acidity with a full body, filling the mouth with fruit and delicate smoky notes, with a long aftertaste.

100% Tinta Roriz from possibly the best Tinta Roriz vineyard in the country. Old, on the slopes of our mountain range and on a stone floor. Very few bottles of a wine as special as it is scarce.

PARCELAS HISTÓRICAS: CERRO DEL BOTICARIO 2020

Tasting notes

Dark red colour, almost black, dense. Very complex nose, lots of red and black fruit, white truffles, peppers, eucalyptus, rockrose and lavender, violets and fresh tobacco, pure chocolate, all in orderly harmony. Huge mouthfeel, opulent but fresh, with surprising acidity, sweet and gentle tannin and full-bodied, with an everlasting aftertaste.

Varieties

100% Garnacha Tintorera. Possibly the best wine made only with Garnacha Tintorera. Vines of very ancient origin, with such low production that we cannot make more than 600 bottles of each vintage. A jewel for very few.

Mastines is a wine that aims to bring the Garnacha Tintorera to its limits and demonstrate its great potential for long aging, resulting in an elegant wine that maintains its fineness while remaining one-of-a-kind. It is made with the best Garnacha Tintorera from a “historic plot,” involving a double selection process of the grapes in the vineyard as well as in the winery. This exclusive process allows us to produce no more than 5000 liters of this wine.

Tasting notes

Deep red color with a cherry rim and bright black reflection. Lilac, wild red flowers, and fresh black fruit. White truffle, monte bajo (Mediterranean wild mountain), and rockrose fruit. Sweet spice. Resinous notes.

Medium ruby colour. Violet aromas on the nose, strawberry, redcurrant, cherry, blackberry, fennel, rockrose, lavender, white pepper, flint, cedar, fine smoked, truffle and wet soil. Intense red fruit in the mouth, good volume, good acidity, freshness, rounded medium-bodied and long finish.

MASTINES CABERNET INDIGENA 2018

Tasting notes

Deep garnet colour. Aromas of red fruit, intense black fruits, pronounced balsamic notes, fennel, anise, rockrose, sweet spices, cedar and subtle toasted notes. Fresh yet opulent palate, broad, full-bodied, with excellent acidity and a long finish dominated by blackcurrant and pepper.

1 Cabernet vines grown under strict dry-farming conditions, producing less than 2000kg/ha
