Metal Packaging Recycling in the UK – Now & Next



Context – Now

- 90%+ UK residents can recycle aerosols at home.
- Aerosols recycled as part of aluminium or steel streams.
- Consumers don't always recycle them correctly; 50% 'capture rate' for metal aerosols!
- 69% recycling rate for aluminium, 78% for steel.



Context – Next

- UK Deposit Return Scheme (DRS) will remove drinks containers from metals from 2027.
- UK Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) system places new, higher recycling targets on aerosols and other packs.
- Aerosols might not be recycled as now without changes to recycling systems.

Aims

- Increase the amount of empty metal aerosols being placed out for recycling by the public.
- Create a blueprint for how those aerosols could be efficiently sorted and sent for recycling.
- Protect the UK aerosols market from excessive and punitive EPR fees and regulations.

Objectives

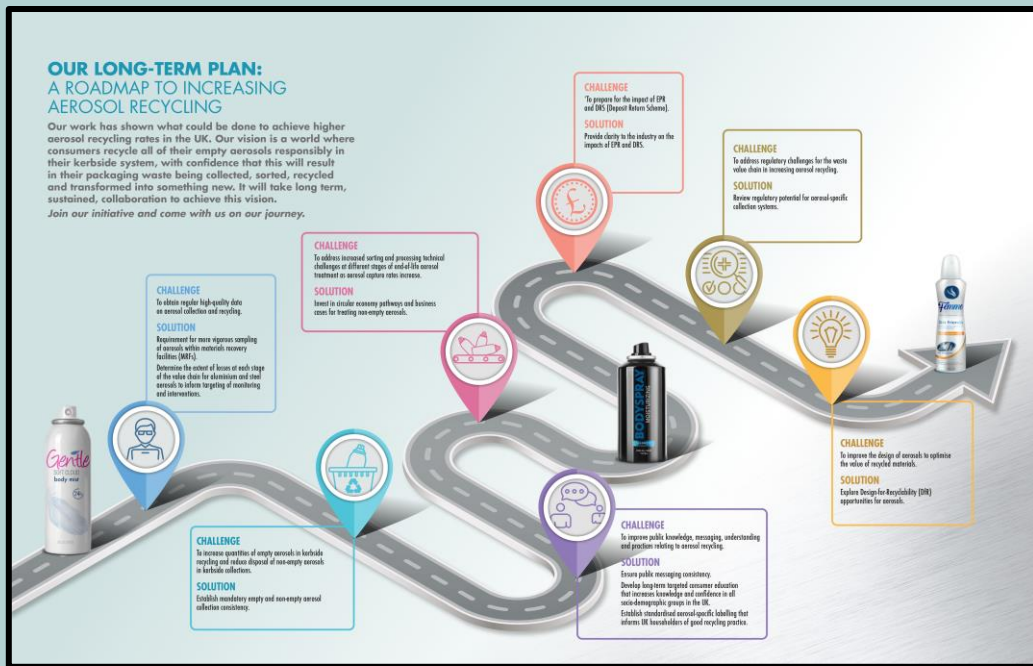
- Improve recycling data quality and granularity, including robust baselines and monitoring.
- Produce effective public behaviour change campaigns that drive up empty aerosol recycling.
- Develop and trial solutions that will overcome barriers to higher aerosol recycling rates.
